

Article 20. In the National Academy of Art can apply to study foreign nationals in the order specified by the Ordinance on the state requirements for admission of students in higher education in Bulgaria.

- Admission of students who are nationals of countries - members of European Union and European Economic Area in the National Academy of Art takes place under the conditions of Art. 68, para. 7 of the Higher Education Act (“The admission of students and postgraduates - citizens of countries - members of European Union and European Economic Area is done in the terms and conditions applicable to Bulgarian nationals”).
- Applicants from countries of the European Union and European Economic Area that do not meet the requirements of Art. 68, para. 7 of the Higher Education Act, upon the decision of the Academic Council of the National Academy can be trained against payment of an annual fee in euros, according to Art. 95, para. 7 of Higher Education Act after completion of verification tests.
- As a condition to foreigners applying in NAA pursuant to Art. 95, para. 7, 8 and 9 to attend a training course in Bulgarian language or successfully pass an exam in Bulgarian language before the enrollment for 1 year.

Article 21. (1) Foreign nationals applying for training in accordance with the Higher Education Act - Art. 95, para. 7 (non-nationals) and para. 9 (persons with dual citizenship) and pursuant to Art. 20, paragraph 2 of this regulation shall submit documents to the National Academy of Art until 31.07.2014 and from 01. 09 to 8.09.2014 on (incl.) and pursuant to Decree № 103, 228 and cultural agreements – at the Ministry of Education, Youth and Science, on a schedule set by the Ministry, which is published on the website of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Science.

(2) Foreign citizens submit the following application documents in the Academy:

- a) application, free text, which indicate the desired specialty;
- b) Curriculum Vitae
- c) certificate of secondary education (translated and legalized) with conclusion that they have the right to continue their education in higher education institutes;
- d) medical certificate (translated and legalized);
- e) photocopy of the national passport;
- f) photocopy of ID card (if the applicant has dual citizenship);
- g) two photographs;

h) proof of knowledge of the Bulgarian language.

In the Ministry of Education, Youth and Science documentation are submitted as described in the Ministry website:

- Foreign nationals who have no document for knowledge of the Bulgarian language are required, pursuant to Art. 20, para. 3 of these Regulations, to have a one-year course in Bulgarian language in the preparatory department in NAA. During the preparatory year they are eligible to attend classes and training in their chosen fields.

Article 22. (1) Checkup tests for foreign nationals are held in the period 10 to 12 September 2014 in a pre-announced schedule of the Academy, observing program for the conduct of examinations with Bulgarian students.

(2) Admitted foreign students enroll on 18 and 19 September 2014, and those who apply through the Ministry of Education – after receiving the decision of the Committee on the admission of foreign students in the Education Ministry.
